EMMA has three assignments for you that are related to the works of art in the exhibition.

In each assignment, you will consider what thoughts and feelings each work of art brings about in you.

You will also learn how to explain your experiences.

Do the assignments during your visit to the museum.

You can write about the works and take photos or videos of them.

Assignment 1

First, listen to what the guide tells you about the works of art in the exhibition.

Then, choose a work of art that makes you think.

Tell the following things about the work:

- What is the subject of the work?
- Why does the work get you thinking?
- Are your thoughts personal?
- Do your thoughts have to do with society,
such as nature or equality between people?

Assignment 2

Choose a work of art that makes you feel something.

Your feelings can be intense or low-key.

Then, tell the following things:

- What is the work of art like?
- Why does the work make you feel something?

- What kind of feelings do you have?
- What other work of art can make you feel the same way?

Assignment 3

Find a design object whose subject or form is familiar to you.

A design object is something people need in their everyday lives.

A design object can be, for example, a drinking glass, door handle, chair or vase.

Now imagine that you are studying the design object again 50 years from now.

Tell something about the object, such as:

- what the object looks like at that time
- whether it can still be used
- what it is used for
- what things you would like to change in the object so that it could last another 50 years.
