
More than 2,000 Espoo residents responded to the city's playground survey

Results of the resident survey related to Espoo's Playground Programme 2026-2036







Background to the resident survey

As part of the process of updating the Playground Programme, a survey was conducted to collect Espoo residents' views about playgrounds. Residents were encouraged to take the survey together with a child or young person in their family. The survey was open from 23 August to 22 September 2024. A total of 2,343 people responded.

The following slides provide a summary of the survey results.








Based on the responses, residents consider it important that playgrounds are located close to home. More than half of the respondents reported visiting their local playground at least once a week. Children usually visit the playground with a parent or grandparent, sometimes also with a friend. People usually get to the playground on foot.

Respondents said that playgrounds offer high-quality activities that are not available in their own yards. The wide range of playground equipment for children of all ages is one of the main reasons for visiting a playground. Families with young children visit playgrounds especially because of the diverse activities they offer.





Colourful equipment, versatile activities and a peaceful environment are important

According to the responses, colourful equipment and the wide range of activities increase the appeal of playgrounds. Respondents also value playgrounds that are close to nature or in an otherwise peaceful environment. The proximity of services is not a decisive factor. What matters more is the location in relation to the resident's home.

Respondents prefer colourful, functional and peaceful playgrounds.






Playgrounds are considered safe and wellmaintained




Respondents of all ages feel that Espoo's playgrounds are generally safe, with disruptive behaviour occurring only rarely. They are also generally considered well-maintained.

The survey responses will be used in the planning of the content of the Playground Programme. The current ten-year programme period ends at the end of 2025, and a new Playground Programme will be drawn up for the years 2026–2036. It will provide guidelines for the construction and maintenance of playgrounds in the coming years. The Playground Programme covers about 200 playgrounds and residents' parks maintained by the city. The programme does not cover playgrounds located in the yards of day care centres and schools.
