

HOUSING INSPECTION REQUEST

Before submitting an inspection request, you must contact the owner of the property or the building manager. We always inform the building manager of the agreed date and time of an inspection, so it is important that their contact information is up to date. The information you provide on this form will be stored in a national register. An inspection report is drawn up on all housing inspections. Inspection reports drawn up by an authority are public, with the exception of confidential information for example relating to a person's health and lifestyle. Documents submitted to an authority are public, unless public access to them is specifically restricted by law (Act on the Openness of Government Activities 621/1999). Inspections are carried out to assess health hazards, and the inspection reports are not suitable for other purposes. For example, they cannot be used as a condition survey report in connection with the sale of a home. The first inspection by an authority to investigate a suspected health hazard and the related assessment of the need for further investigations are free of charge. A fee is charged for other measures related to housing health in line with the price list approved by the Espoo City Board. Inspections are conducted and inspection reports are drawn up primarily in Finnish.
